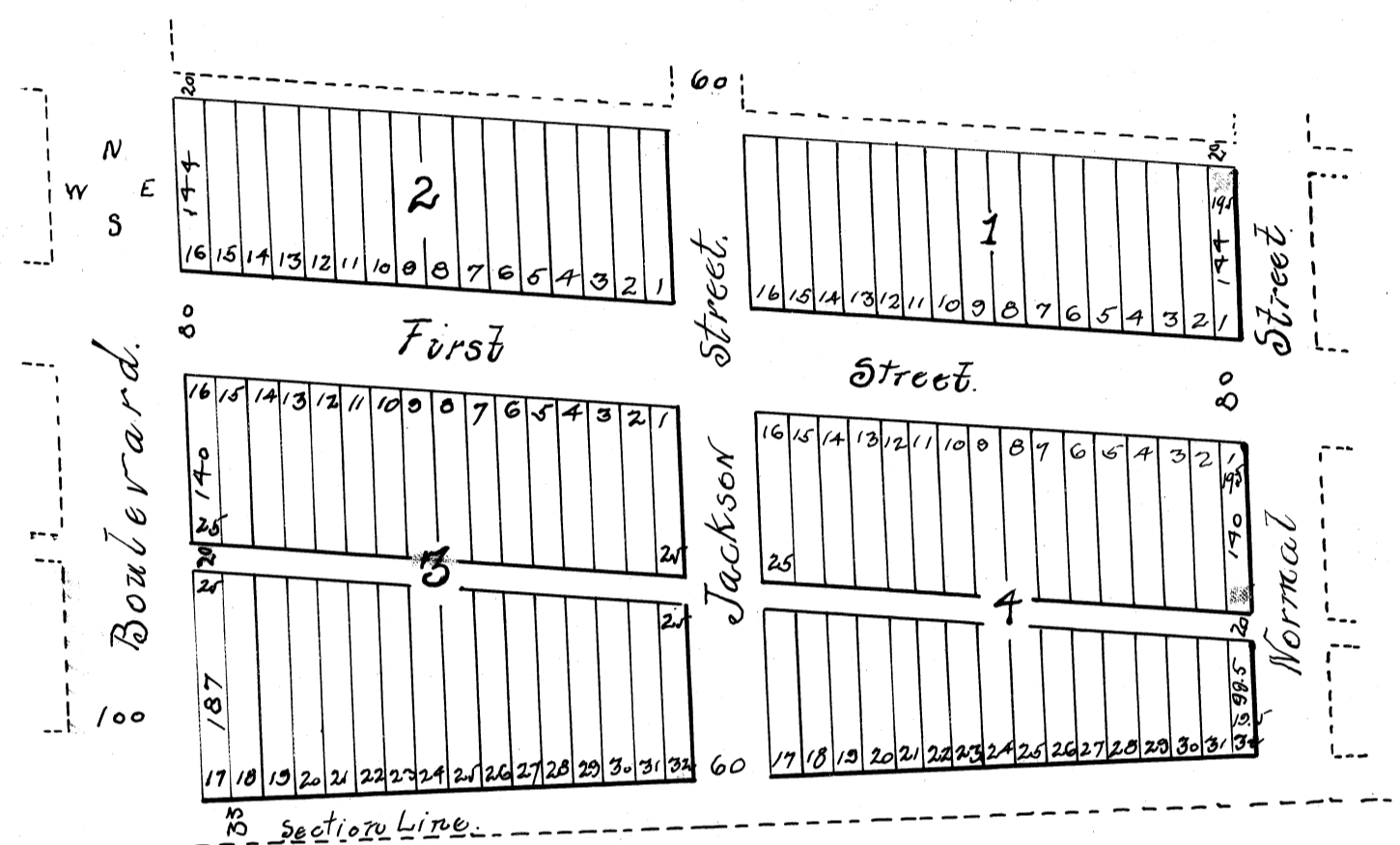


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Andron H. Classen's sixth addition to the City of Edmond, Oklahoma.

This instrument witnesseth that I Andron H. Classen, of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Territory, the owner of the land hereinafter described, have caused the same to be surveyed into Lots, Blocks, Streets, Avenues and Alleys, for townsite purposes, and I hereby designate and name the same as Andron H. Classen's 6th Addition to the City of ^{Edmond} Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory. That I have caused to be made a correct plat of the same land as surveyed; that the land surveyed and platted as aforesaid is described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the West line of Normal Street, as laid out, and the North line of First Street, as laid out, in the city of Edmond, running thence North along the west line of said Normal Street 144 Feet, thence West and parallel with the North line of First Street 854.5 Feet to the East line of the Boulevard, so called, thence South along the said East Line 571 Feet to a point 33 Feet North of Section Line, Thence East parallel with said Section Line 850 Feet, thence North 339.5 Feet to the point of beginning, being a part of the South West quarter of section 25 Township 14, North, Range 3, West.
