

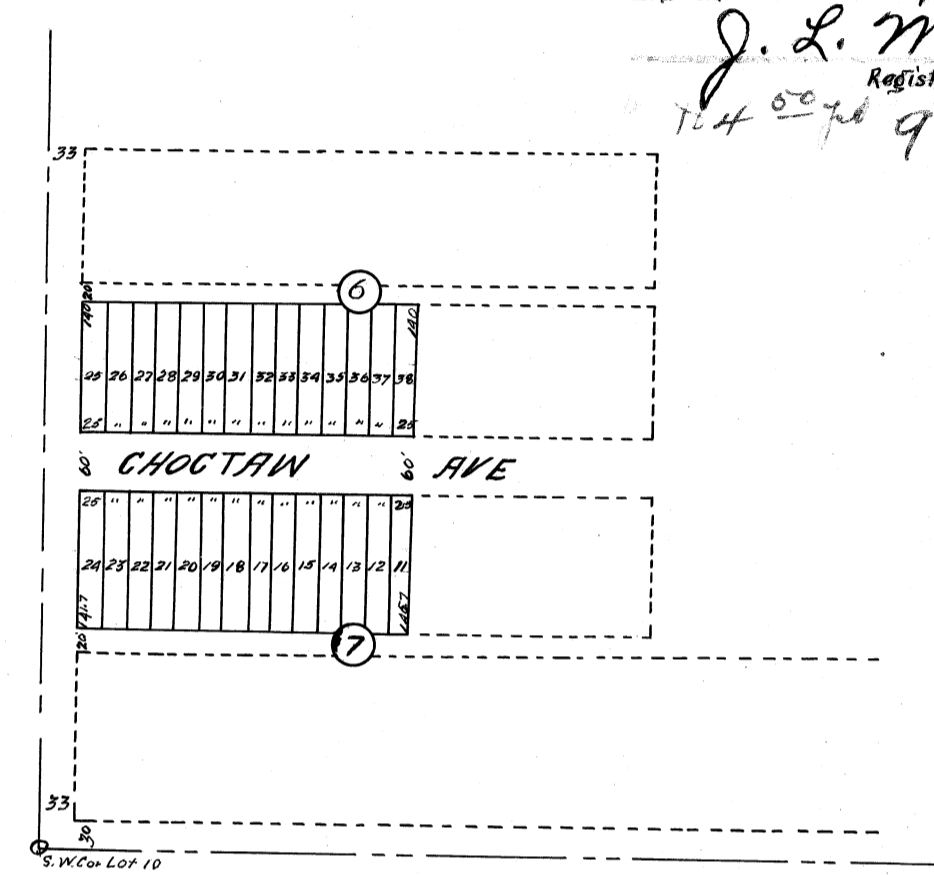
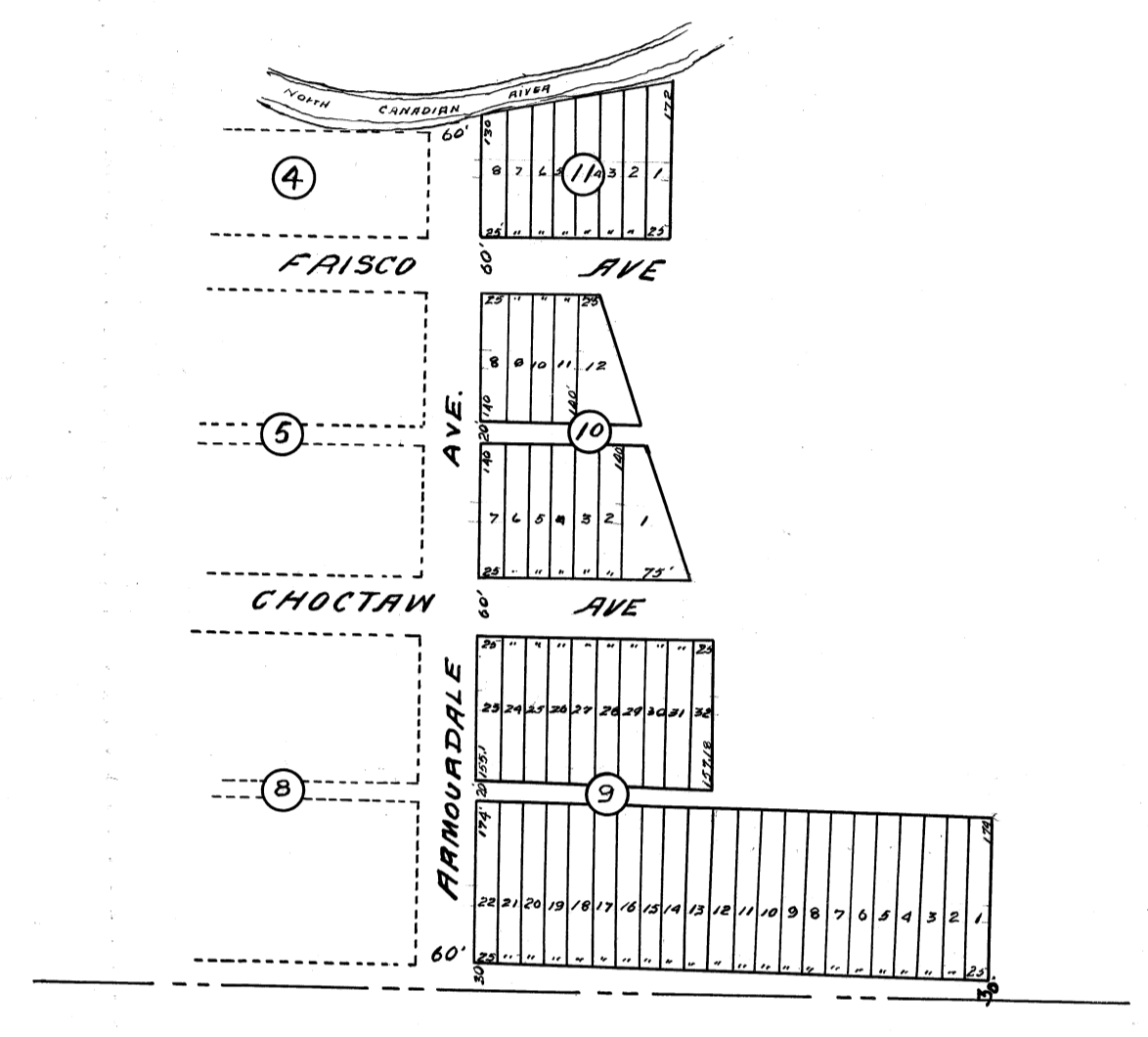
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# ARMOURDALE ADDITION TO OKLAHOMA CITY OKLAHOMA

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the Armour-Dale Park and Improvement Company, being the owner of part of the northwest quarter of section two (2), township eleven (11), North of Range three (3) West Indian Meridian, more particularly described as follows:- Commencing 693 feet east of the southwest corner of said quarter section, thence North 912.2 feet to the south bank of the North Canadian River, thence easterly along said bank 260 feet, thence south 172 feet to the north line of Frisco Avenue, as laid out in Armour-Dale Addition produced, thence west 75 feet thence south 60 feet, thence south-easterly to the intersection with the south line of Choctaw Avenue as laid out in Armour Dale Addition produced and a distance of 310 feet east of the northeast corner of block eight (8) of said addition, thence south 177.18 feet, thence east 300 feet, thence south 204 feet, thence west 610 feet to the point or place of beginning, have caused the same to be surveyed into lots, blocks, streets and alleys which we hereby dedicate and name as supplemental plat to Armour-Dale Addition. Also a part of said quarter section described as follows:  
 Beginning at a point 160 feet south of the northwest corner of block six (6) of Armour Dale Addition to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory, as the same appears in the recorded plat thereof, thence south 361.7 feet, thence east 350 feet, thence north 365.7 feet, thence west 350 feet to the point or place of beginning, and have caused the same

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to be surveyed into lots, street and alley which we hereby  
dedicate and name second supplementary plat to Armour-  
Dale Addition to Oklahoma City, Oklahoma Territory, and that
