Plat of Aurora Addition to Oklahoma City, Okla.

Know all men by these presents that we, Peter Billen and Barbara Billen, his wife, the owners thereof, have caused to be surveyed and platted into blocks and streets the following described estate in Oklahoma County, Territory of Oklahoma, to wit:

A part of the West half of the North east quarter of Section Thirt in Township Twelve North of Range Three West Indian Meridian described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the North west corner of said quarter section and running east along the North line of said quarter section one hundred and thirty feet to a point; thence east parallel with the north line of said quarter section seven hundred and thirty feet to a point; thence south parallel with the west line of said quarter section to the south line thereof; thence east on the south line of said quarter section to the east line of the west half of said quarter section; thence north on the east line of said west half of said quarter section to the north line thereof; thence west on the north line of said west half of said quarter section to the place of beginning.

And we hereby adopt the map and plat set out on the annexed sheet as a correct representation of the said survey and we name the land surveyed "Aurora Addition to Oklahoma City, Okla." and we hereby dedicate the streets to the use of the public order.
