Know all Men by these presents.

That E. G. Bedford, the owner of that part of the N. E. 1/4 Section Thirty-four Township Thirteen North of Range One West lying South of the St. Louis and San Francisco R. R. Rt of way has caused a part of the same to be surveyed into lots, blocks, streets avenues and alleys and that a correct map or plat of said land as surveyed is set out on this sheet is hereby adopted as such and said land so surveyed is hereby named Bedford's Addition to Jones Oklahoma. The streets avenues and alleys are dedicated to the public use of said town. — Land more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point Two hundred & Sixty Three (263) feet South of the N. W. corner of the N. E. quarter of Sec 34. T 13 N. R. 1 W. Thence South and along one half Section line Fourteen hundred Sixty-eight (1468) feet thence East Thirteen Twenty (1320) feet thence North Thirteen hundred ninety and six tenths (1390.6) feet to the South line of the St. Louis and San Francisco Railroad Right-of-way thence N 85 degree's 45 minutes W along said Right-of-way line to the point or place of beginning excepting a piece of land in the North-west corner of above described land known as Prentiss Addition to Jones and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point Two hundred Sixty Three (263) feet South of the North-West corner of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty-four Township Thirteen North Range One West thence South and along one-half Section line Three hundred Eighteen (318) feet thence North Three hundred (300) feet to the South line of the St. Louis and San Francisco Railroad Right-of-way; thence westerly along said South line of Right-of-way to point or place of beginning.
