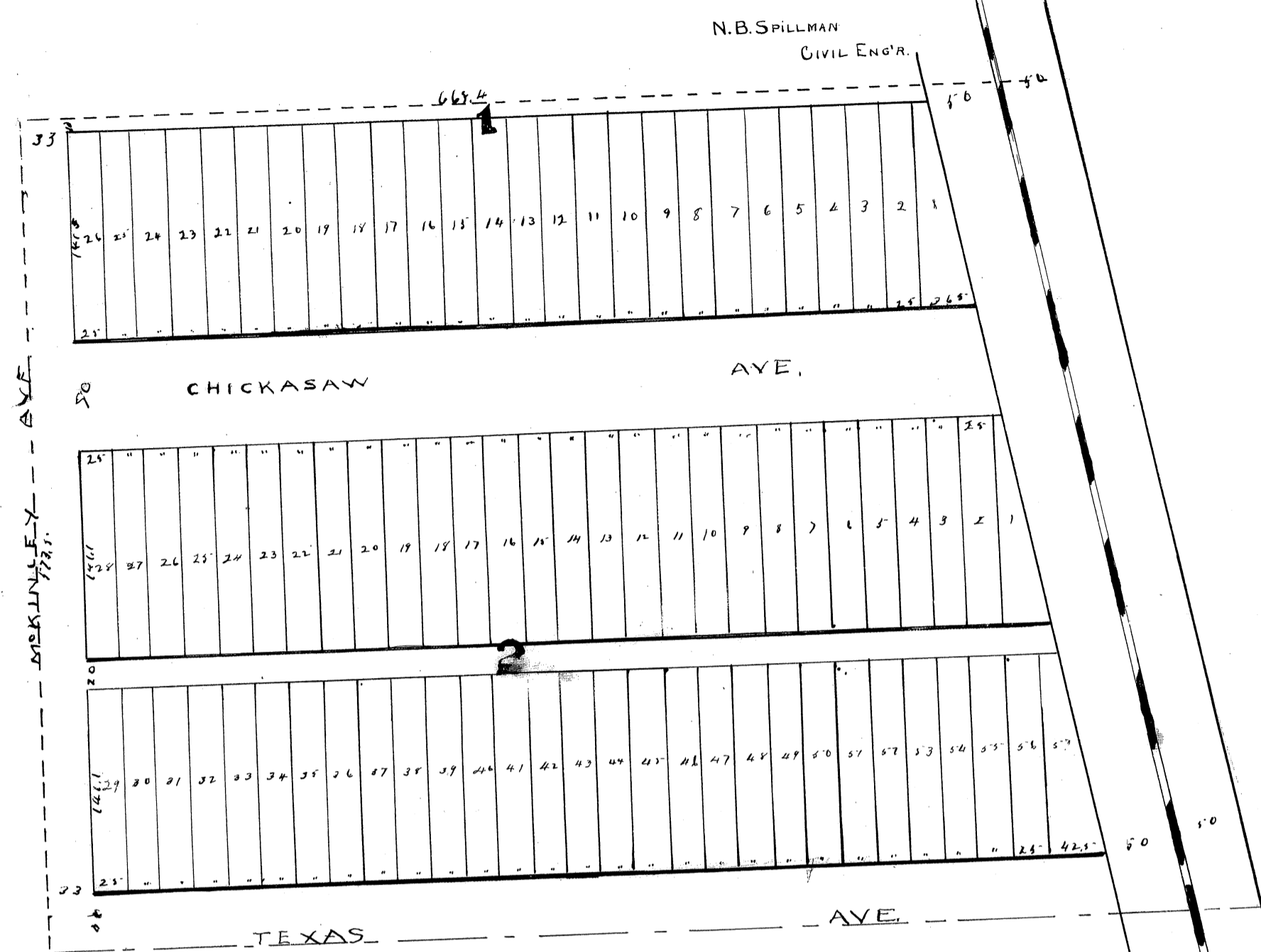


BELFORT ADDITION TO

This instrument witnesseth that we Louis Belfort and Mary A. Belfort of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory, the owners of the land hereinafter described have caused the same to be surveyed into blocks, lots, streets and alleys for townsite purposes and do hereby designate and name the same Belfort Addition to Oklahoma City. That we have caused to be made a correct plat of said land as surveyed that the land surveyed and platted aforesaid is described and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a point eleven hundred and seventeen and four tenths (1117.4) ft. north of the south-west corner of the N.W. 1/4 of section four (4) Township Eleven (11) Range Three (3) West thence north five hundred and seventy-nine and five tenths (579.5) ft. thence east six hundred and thirty-eight and five tenths (638.5) ft. thence south 11° 10' east five hundred and ninety and four tenths (590.4) ft. thence west to beginning. And we do hereby dedicate the streets and alleys as surveyed to the public use forever.
