

This instrument witnesseth that we C. E. Bennett and Harry L. Gerson of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory, the owners of the land hereinafter described have caused the same to be surveyed into Blocks, Lots, streets, Avenues and Alleys for townsite purposes and we hereby designate and name the same as Bennett and Gerson Addition to Oklahoma City. That we have caused to be made a correct plat of said land as surveyed that the land as surveyed and platted aforesaid is described, as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the N.E. cor of the N.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 33, Twp 12 N of R 3 W. Running thence westerly and along the North line of said above described N.E. 1/4, 1260 ft. Thence southerly 673 ft to a point on the North line of Right-of-way of the C. O. & G. R. R. and distant 1260 ft from the East line of the above described 1/4 Section of land. Thence Easterly and along the said line of Right-of-way 1260 ft Thence Northerly and along the East line of said 1/4 Sec 710 ft to place of beginning. 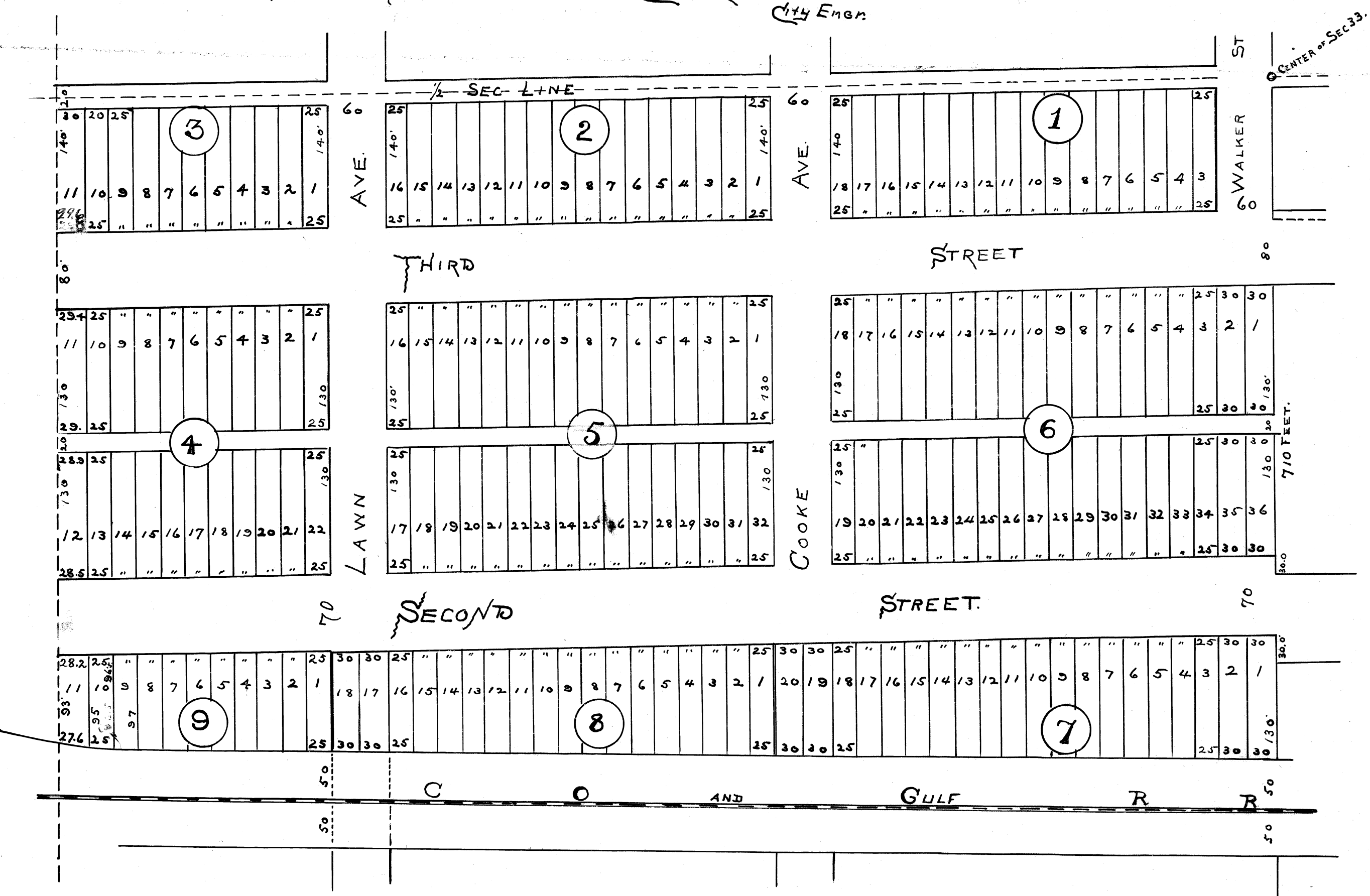
