Know All Men by these Presents, That W. R. Caldwell and M. A. Caldwell husband and wife owners of the land hereinafter described have caused to be surveyed and plotted into lots, blocks and alleys the land hereinafter described that the map and plat set out on this sheet is a true and correct representation of said land as surveyed. That the land so surveyed and plotted is situated in Oklahoma County Territory of Oklahoma and is described as follows, to-wit: a part Northeast Quarter of Section Nine of Township 11 South of Range 3 West of Indian Meridian. Bounded as follows to-wit: Beginning at the at the southeast corner of Caldwell's addition to Oklahoma City as heretofore platted running thence northerly on a line parallel to and fifty feet from the center line of the track of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe railroad a distance of 109 1/2 thence fifty feet West, running thence northerly on a line parallel to and 100 feet from the center of said Railroad track a distance of 1330 ft to the south bank of the North Canadian River, running thence in a general southwesterly direction along said south bank of said river to the east side of Robinson Street in Oklahoma City, projected south running thence south along the east side of said Robinson Street, to the north west corner of Caldwell's addition to Oklahoma as heretofore platted, running thence east along the north line of said Caldwell's addition to the point of beginning.

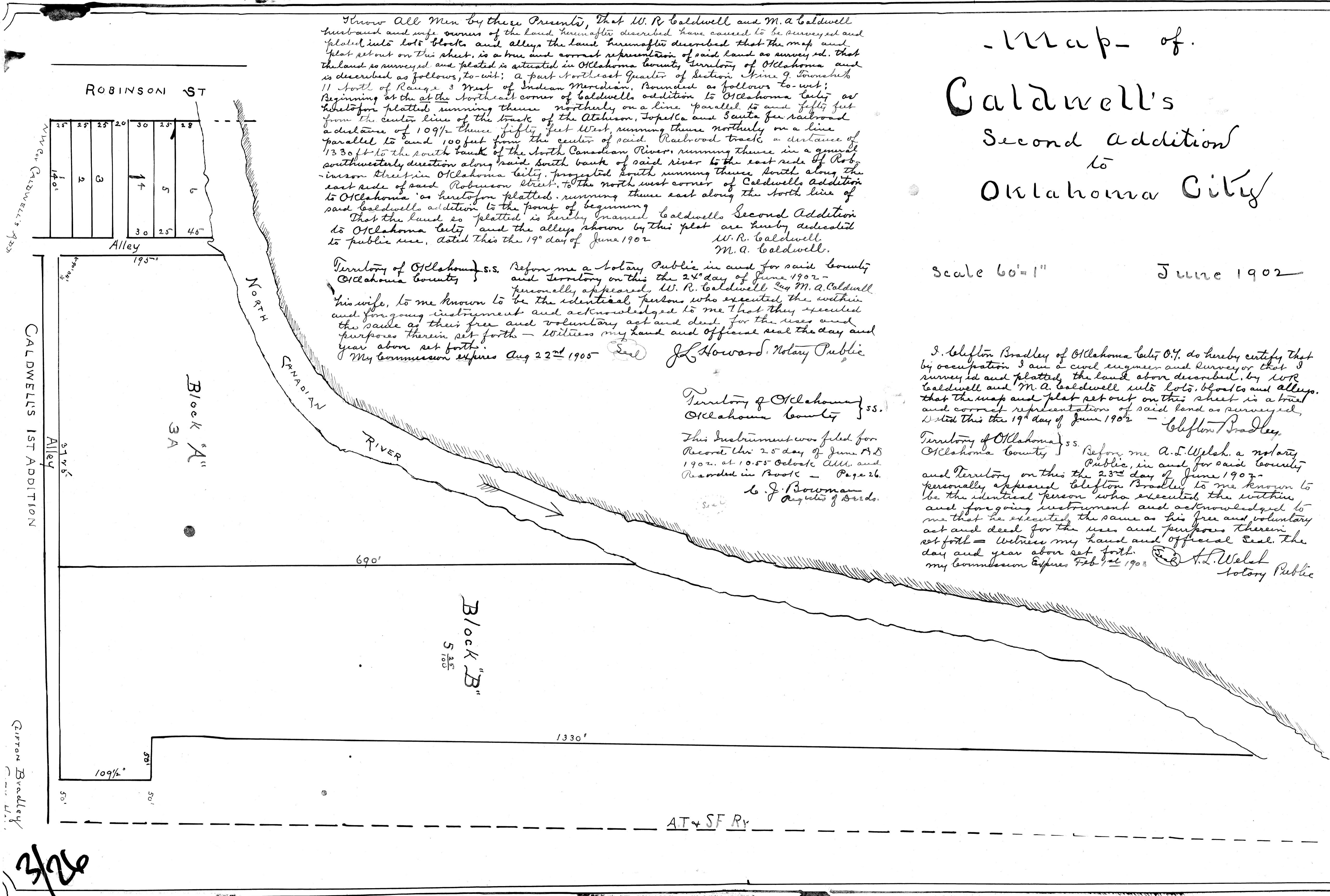
