Certificate of Civil Engineer

Territory of Oklahoma, Oklahoma County, SS. I, N. B. Spillman, a resident of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory, do hereby certify that I am by profession a civil engineer and surveyor, that on or about the 17th day of May 1902, at the instance of Lulu A. Carey and Lucy E. Weaver, I surveyed into lots, blocks, streets and alleys, the following described property to-wit: Commencing at a point 1099 feet east of the N.W. corner of the Southwest quarter of section thirty three (33) Township 2N. Range 9E. North of Range 9E. West of the Indian Meridian; thence east along north line of said quarter two hundred and seventy nine and five tenths (279.5) feet; thence south six hundred and sixty seven and seventy seven hundredths (667.77) feet to an intersection with the north line of the C.O. & F.R.R. right of way, thence along said north line of said right of way in a direction a little north of west a distance of two hundred and eighty four and six tenths (284.6) feet; thence north a distance of six hundred and thirty three hundredths (630.33) feet to the place of beginning, containing 4.164 acres. The same being designated as Carey & Weaver's Addition to Oklahoma City, O. T.
