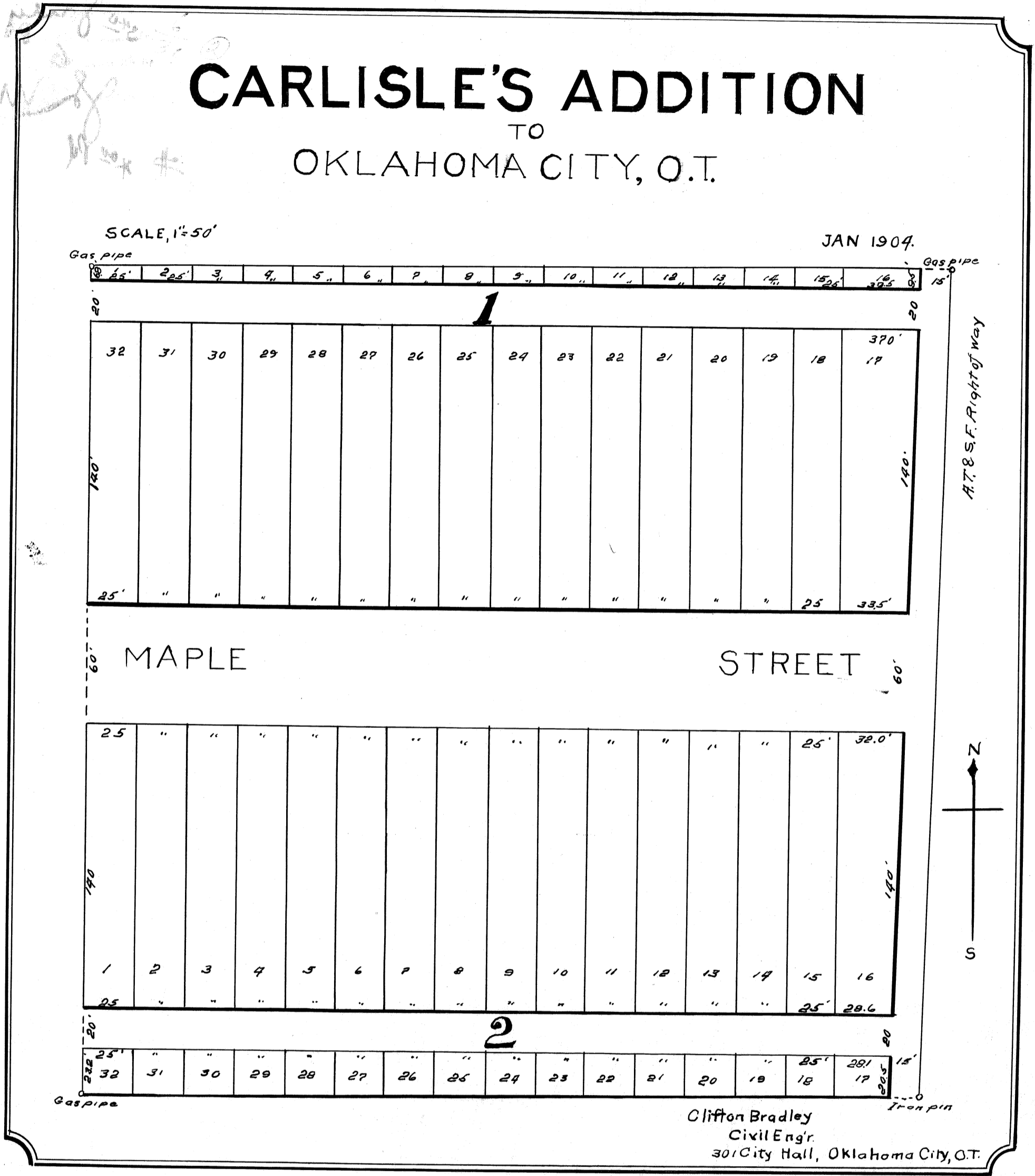

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Plan of ~~Carlisle~~ ADDITION to Oklahoma City, O. T.

BEFORE ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:— that we, Charles S. Carlisle and Elizabeth A. Carlisle, his wife, owners, have caused to be surveyed into lots, blocks, street and alleys the following described tract of land situate in Oklahoma County, O. T., to-wit:— Commencing at a point on the West edge of the right of way of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway, 910 feet South of the East and West Quarter line of Section Four, Township Eleven North, Range Three West of the Tenth Meridian, thence West 427.6 feet to the East edge of South Park Addition Oklahoma City, thence South along said addition 410 feet, thence East 410.6 feet to the edge of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway right of way, thence Northerly 410 feet to the place of beginning; and we hereby adopt the plat set out on the attached sheet as a correct representation of said survey and name

the land so surveyed "Carlisle Addition to Oklahoma City".

We hereby dedicate the street and alleys to public use forever.
