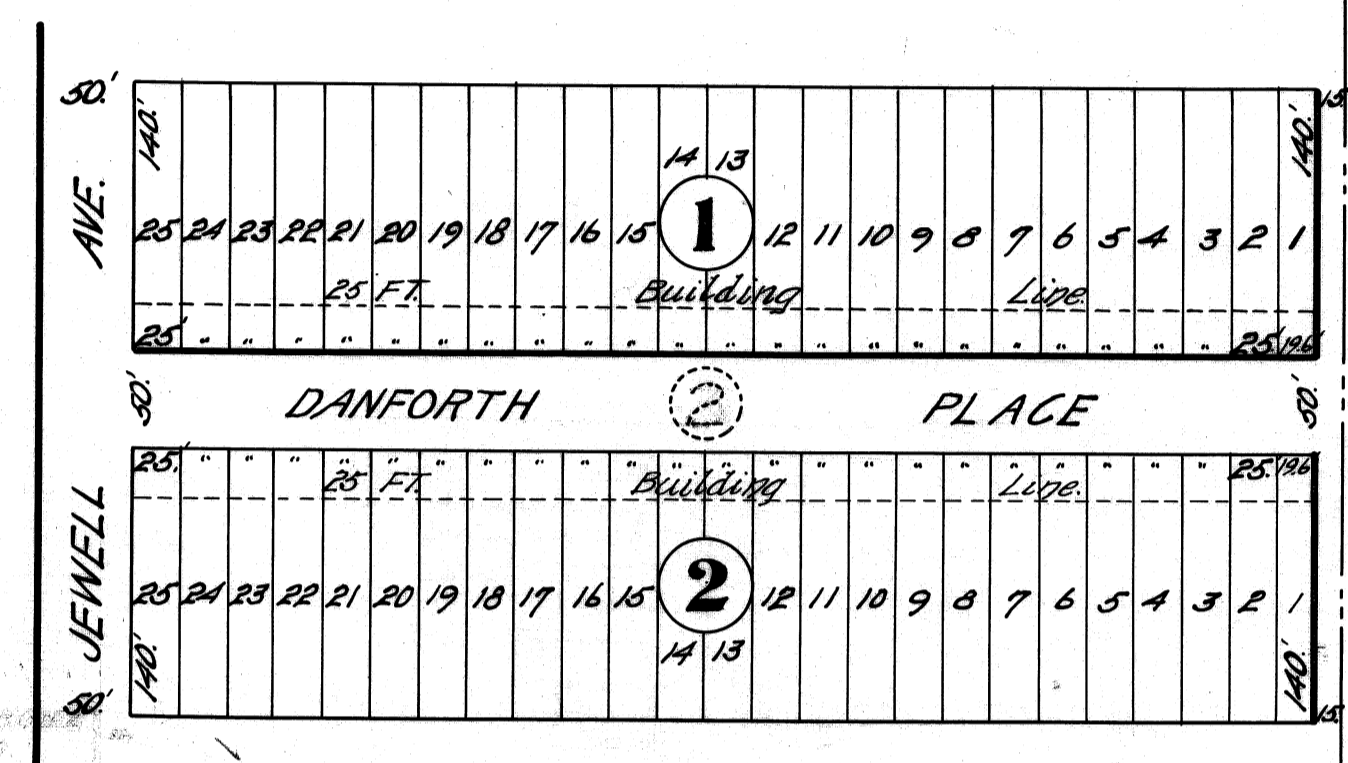

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That R. C. Danforth, and Minnie Danforth his
wife, being the owners of Block Two (2) Jewell Heights Addition, to Oklahoma
City, Oklahoma, have caused the same to be sub-divided into lots, blocks,
streets and that the annexed map or plat is a correct representation of said
block as sub-divided which we hereby designate and name Danforth Place, and
dedicate the streets as shown on said map or plat to the public.

RESTRICTIONS:

1. -----A Building line is hereby established
obligatory on all purchasers of said
lots twenty five feet from all front streets, no
buildings except porches and steps to a distance
of eight feet or less shall be allowed to project
over said building line.
2. ----- No lot or lots or any portion of either shall
ever be sold to any person of African descent
known as Negroes.
