

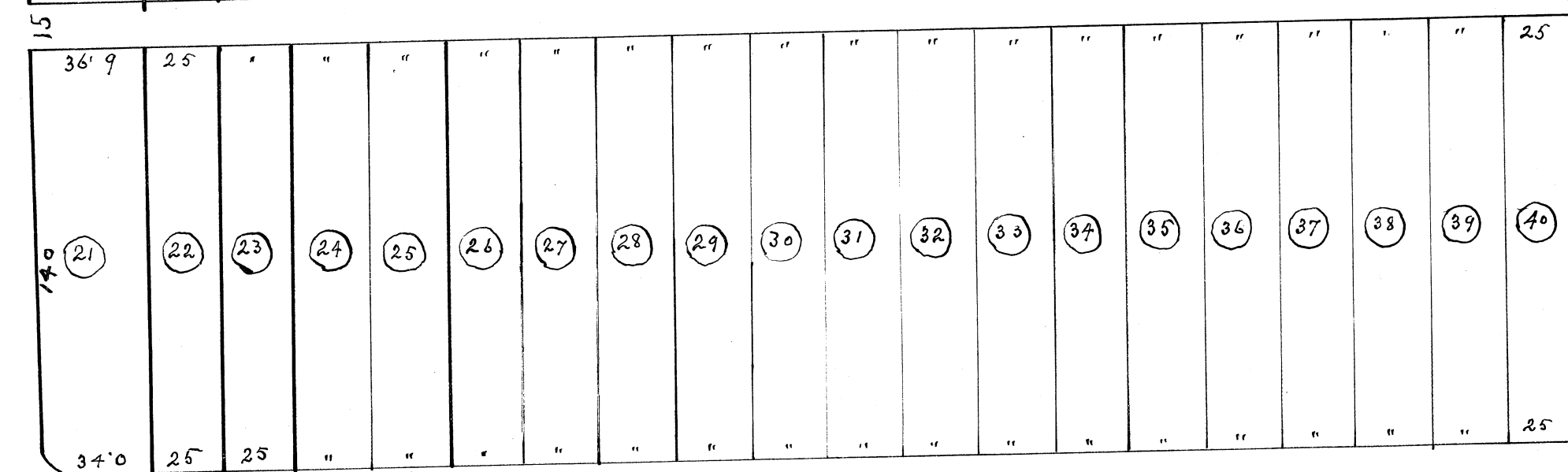
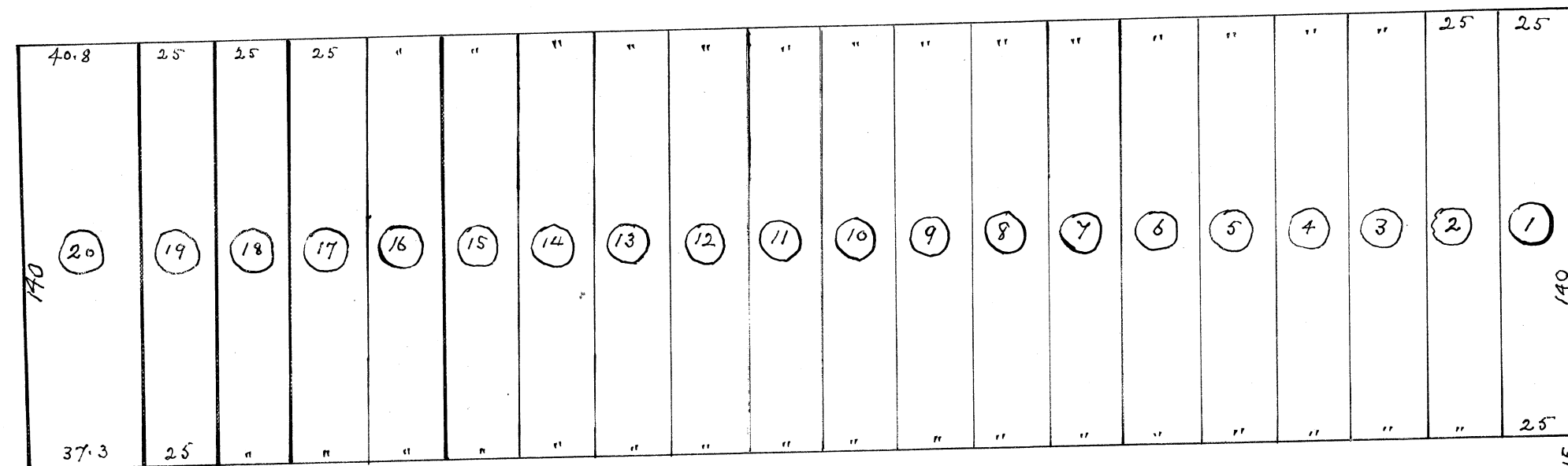
DESOTO ADDITION TO OKLAHOMA CITY

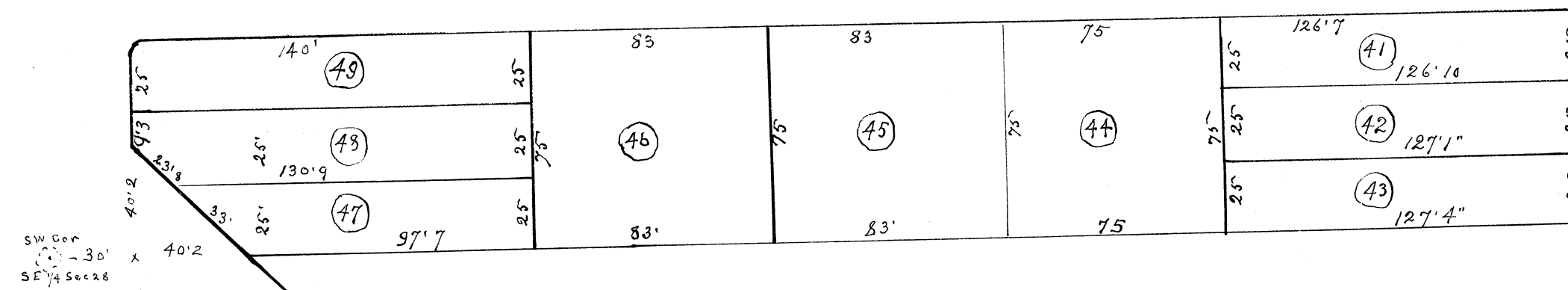

Know all Men by these Presents:
That the Sisters of Mercy of St. Mary's Academy of Sacred Heart,
Oklahoma Territory, a Corporation created by special act of the Legislative Assembly of
the Territory of Oklahoma, has caused to be platted and surveyed into Lots, Streets and Alleys the
land herein after described; That the Map and Plat set out on this sheet is a correct representation of
said land as surveyed; That the land so surveyed is named "De Soto Addition to Oklahoma City";
That the streets and Alleys shown on this Map and Plat are hereby dedicated to Public use;
That the land so surveyed and platted is situated in Oklahoma County, Territory of Oklahoma, and is
described as follows, to-wit; A part or portion of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter
of Section Twenty Eight (28), Township Twelve (12) North of Range Three (3) West of Indian Meridian
bounded as follows, to-wit; beginning at the Southwest Corner of said Quarter Section; running thence East
along the South line of said Quarter Section a distance of 523 feet more or less to the west line of Hudson
Avenue, in Oklahoma City, projected in a straight line into said Quarter Section; -running thence northwesterly
and along the west line of said Hudson Avenue, so projected a distance of 430 feet; -running thence West
on a line parallel with the South line of said Quarter Section to the West line of said Quarter Section; -running
thence South along the West line of said Quarter Section a distance of 430 feet to the point of beginning.
