Mead husband and wife owners of the hereinbefore mentioned land have caused to be surveyed and platted into lots, blocks, streets and alley, and we hereby designate the same as "Douglas Flat" an addition to the city of Oklahoma, Oklahoma County Territory of Oklahoma, and we hereby dedicate the streets and alley to the public use: We further certify that the above and foregoing is a correct plat of the same as surveyed and platted.

That the land so surveyed and platted is that part of the South-west Quarter of the South-east Quarter of section thirty-four in Township twelve North, Range three west of Indian Meridian described as follows:  
 Beginning at a point on the South line of said South-west Quarter of the South-east Quarter 660 feet East of the South-east corner thereof and thence East 500 feet more or less to the center of the channel of the North Fork of the Canadian River: Thence up said river with the center of the channel and the meanderings thereof in a Northerly and Northwesterly direction to where said channel intersects a line drawn North & South which line is 600 feet East of the West line of the said South-west Quarter of the South-east Quarter Thence South 1046.4 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
