

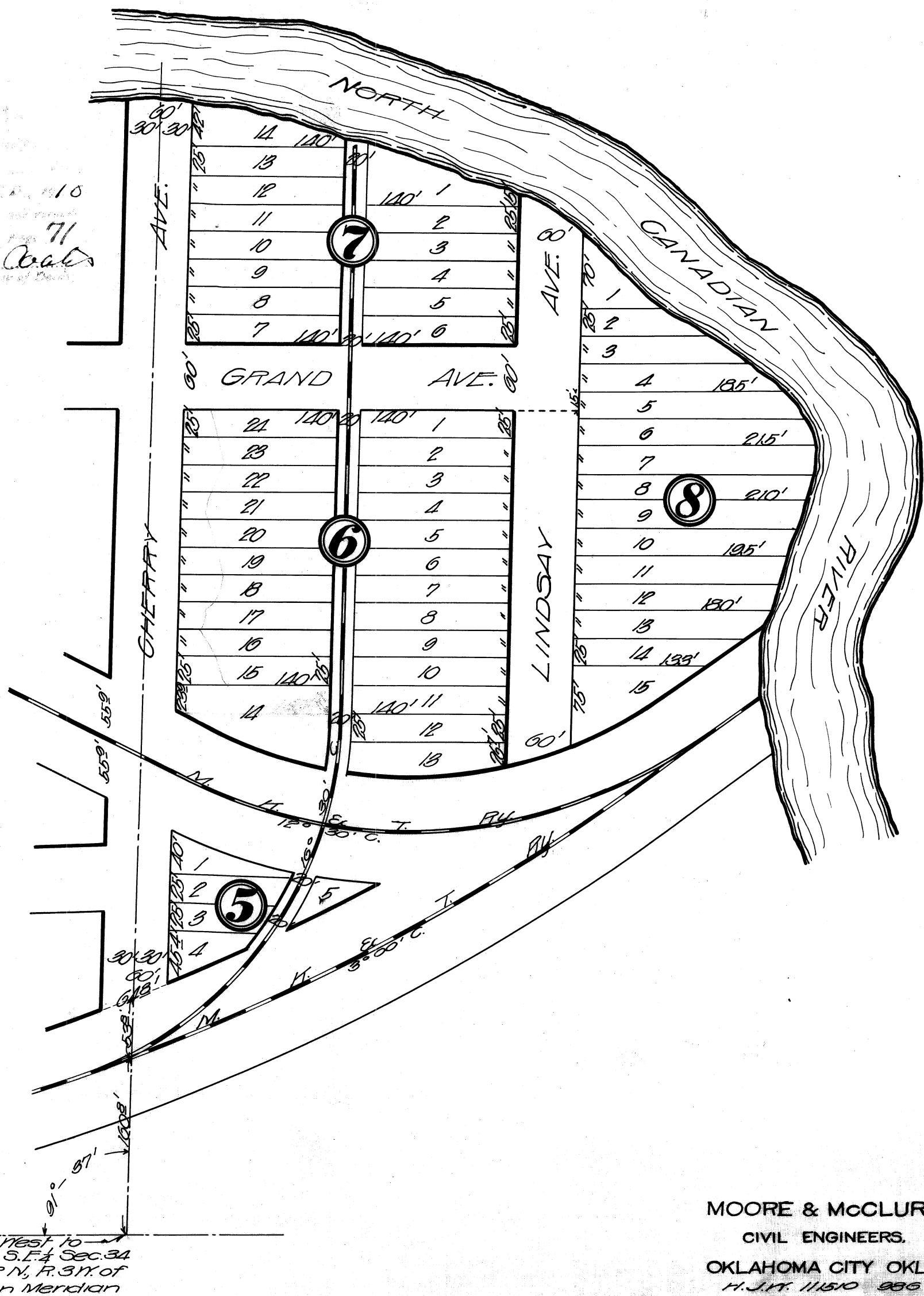
# EAST GRAND AVENUE ADDITION

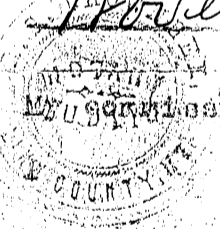
The alley in Block Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7) is hereby reserved for switch track purposes.
