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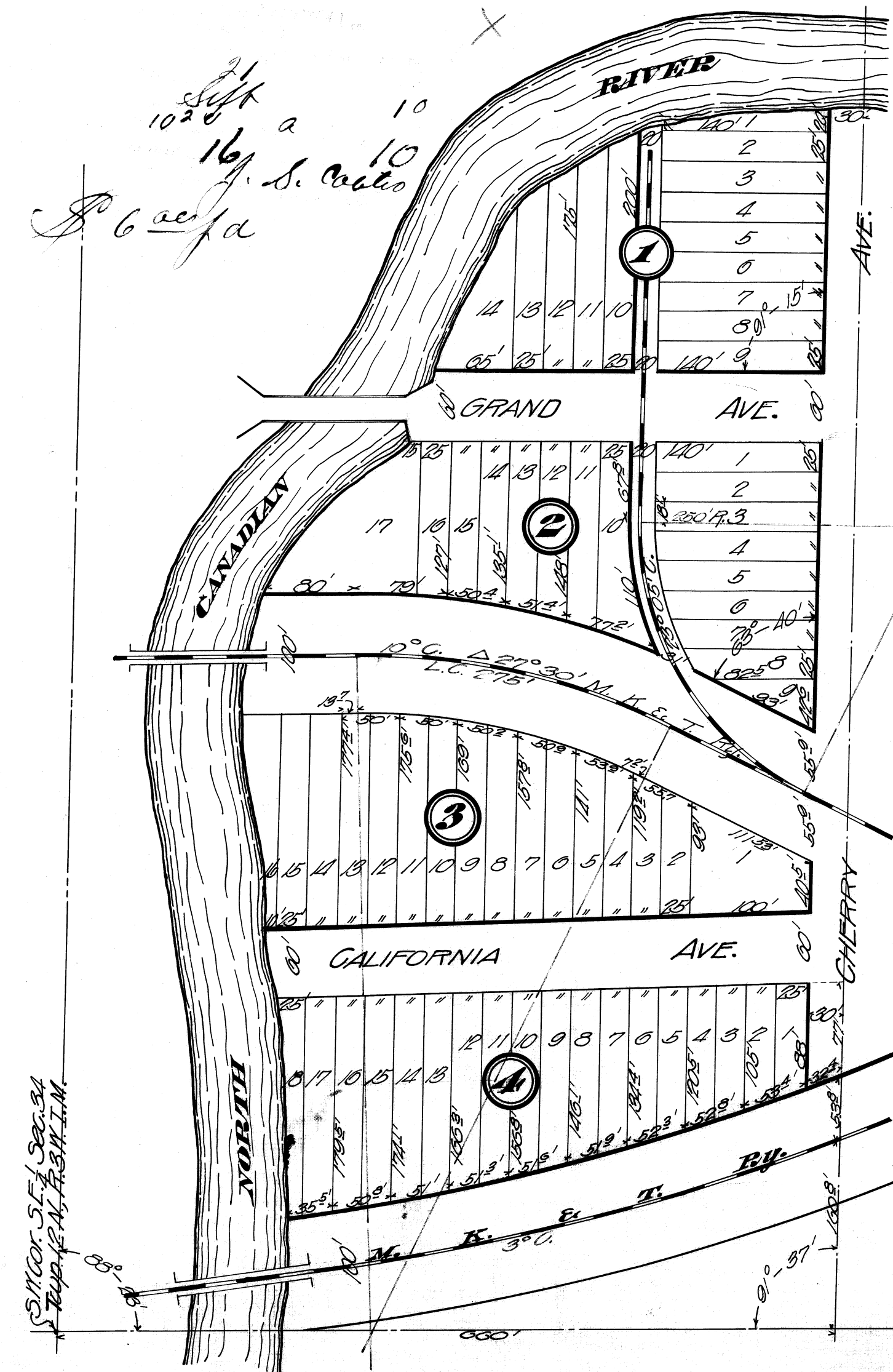
# EAST GRAND AVENUE ADDITION

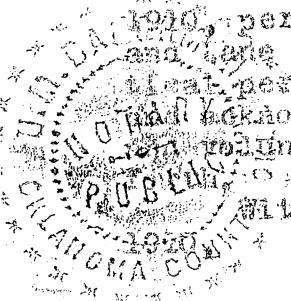
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Grant Egbert and Daisy Egbert his wife, being the owners of that part of the West Half (W. 1/2) of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Twelve (12) North of Range Three (3) West of the Indian Meridian, and lying North of the spur-line of the M.K. & T. Railroad and the North Canadian River shown on the annexed map or plat as Blocks One (1) and Two (2), and Dane E. Hemenway a single man, being the owner of that part of the West Half (W. 1/2) of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Twelve (12) North of Range Three (3) West of the Indian Meridian, and lying between the North Right-of-way line of the M. K. & T. Railroad, and the South Right-of-way line of spur track of said railroad, and East of the North Canadian River, as shown on the annexed map or plat as Blocks Three (3) and Four (4), have caused the same to be subdivided into blocks, lots, streets, and alleys, and that the annexed map or plat is a correct representation of said lands as subdivided, which we hereby designate and name, "East Grand Avenue Addition," to Oklahoma City, and dedicate the streets as shown on said map or plat to the public, and the alley in Block One (1) and Block Two (2), lying North of the spur-track of the M. K. & T. Railroad is hereby reserved for side-track purposes.

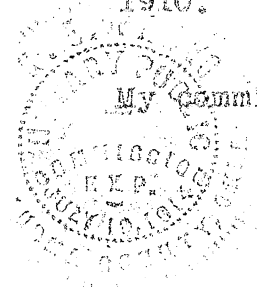
