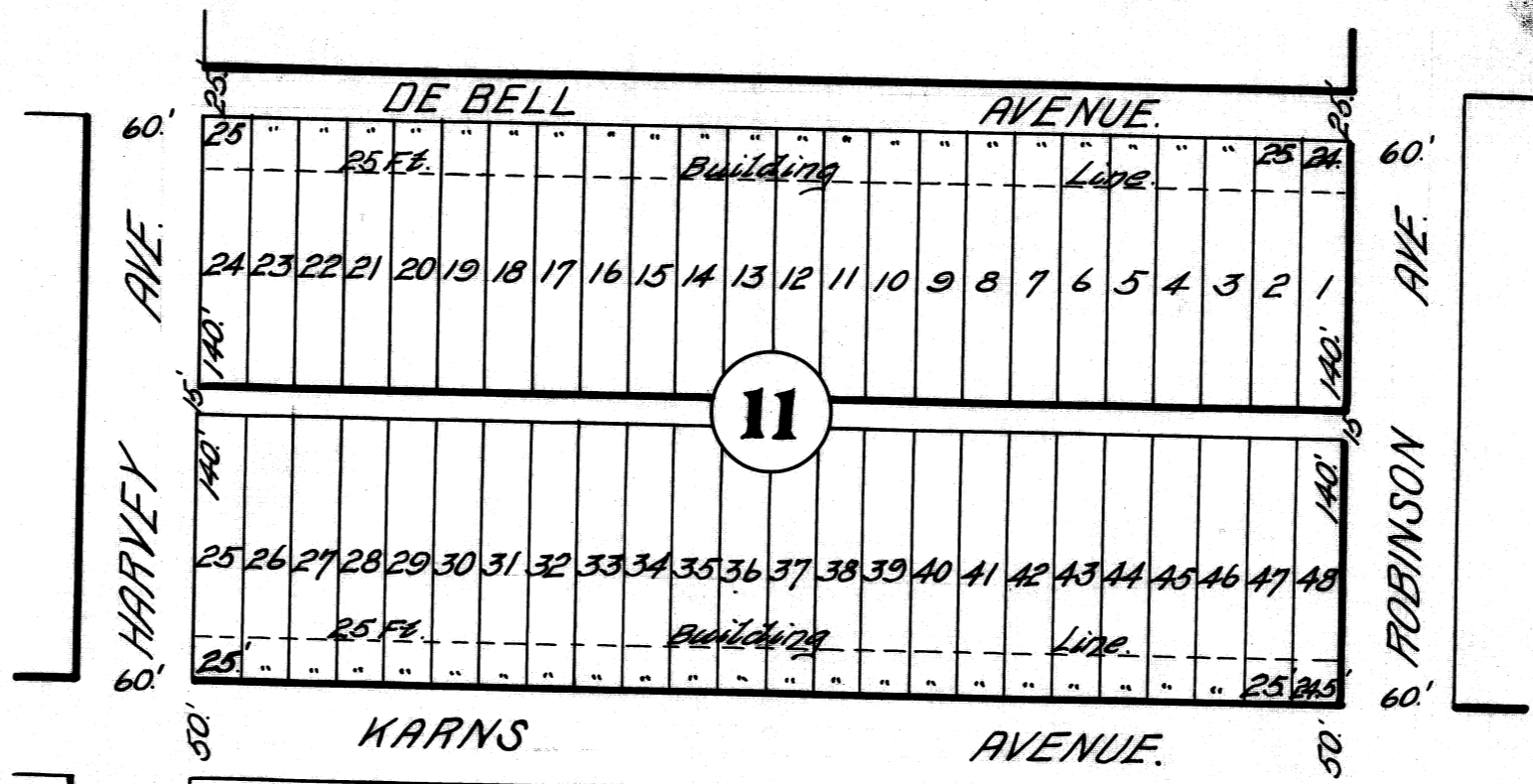

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That C. W. Williams and Edith F. Williams
his wife, being the owners of Block 11, Edkol Heights Addition to Oklahoma
City, Oklahoma, have caused the same to be sub-divided into lots streets and
an alley, and that the annexed map or plat is a correct representation of
said block as sub-divided and we hereby dedicate the streets and alley ~~to~~ as
