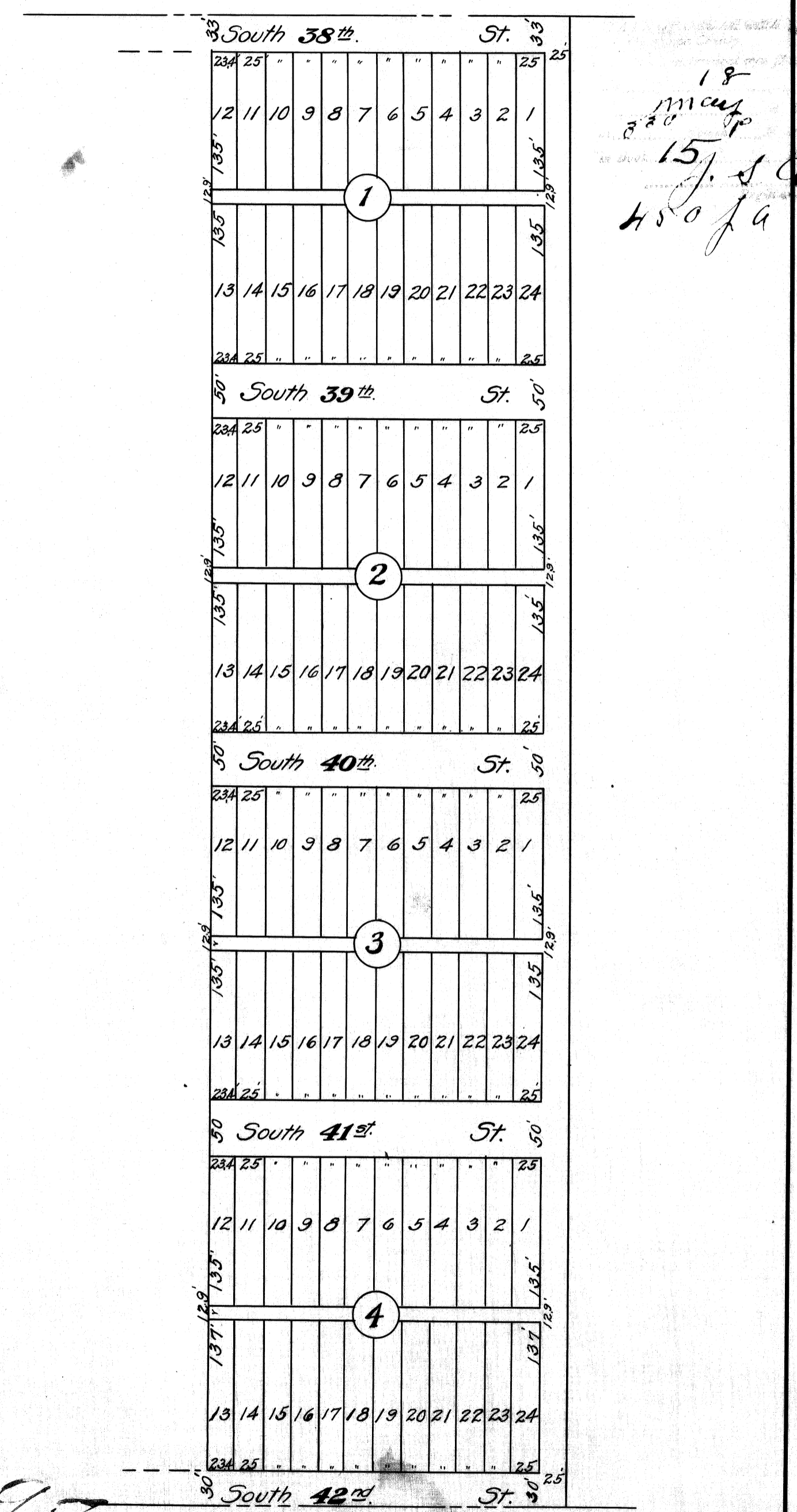


F. G. MARTIN'S
