

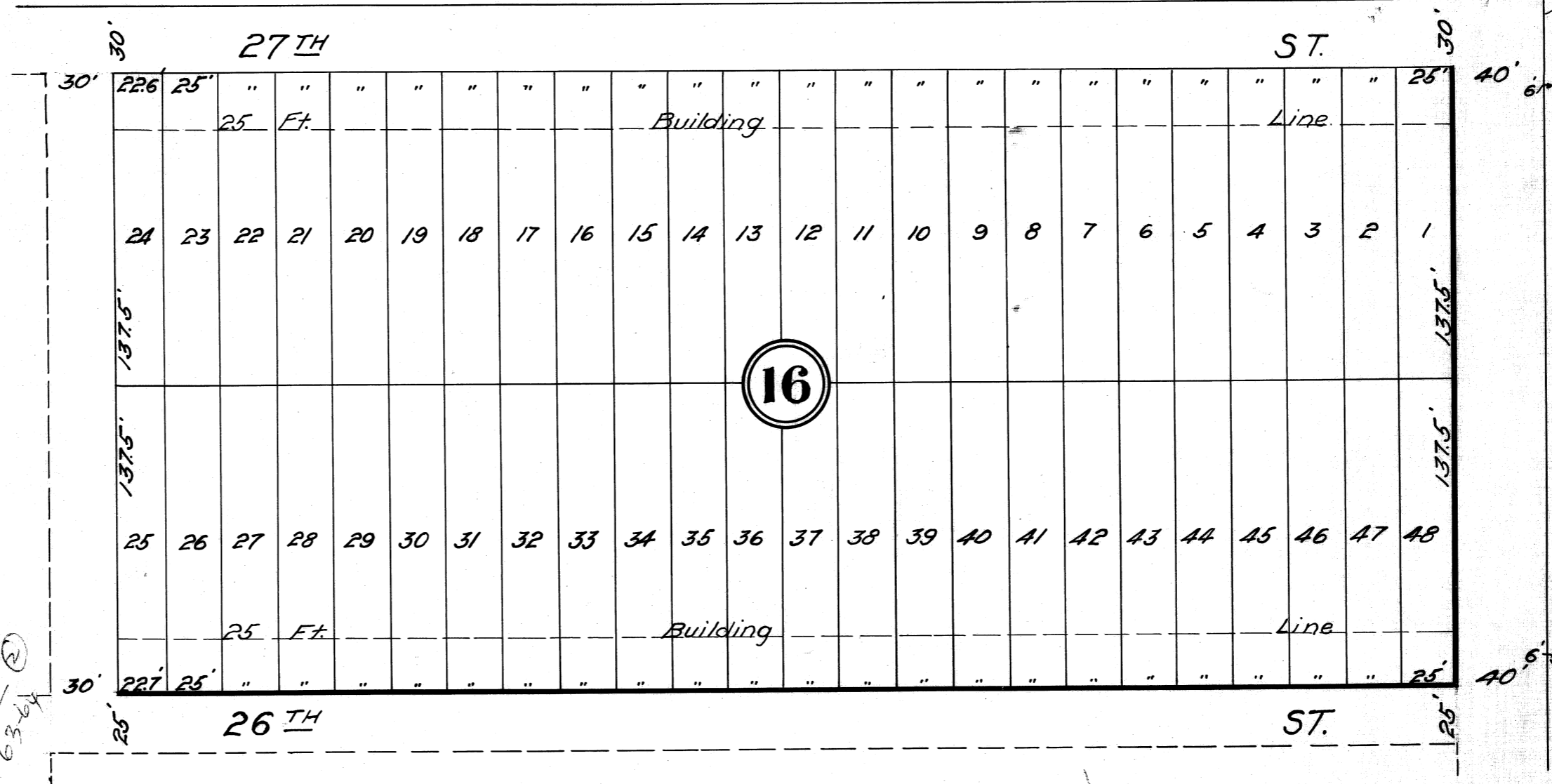

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:- That Robert H. Wilkin and Minnie K. RESTRICTIONS:

No. 2- A building line is hereby established obligatory on all purchasers of lots in this Block a distance of Twenty-Five (25') Feet from all front streets.
