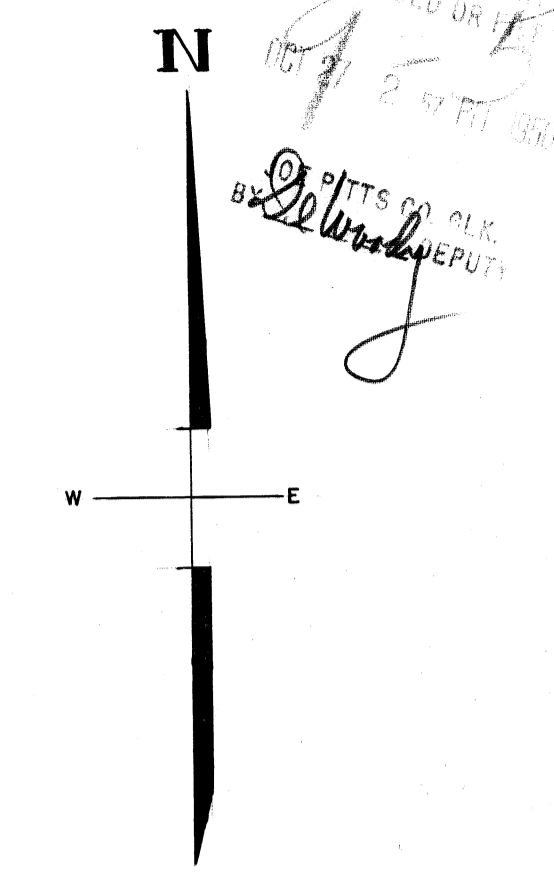
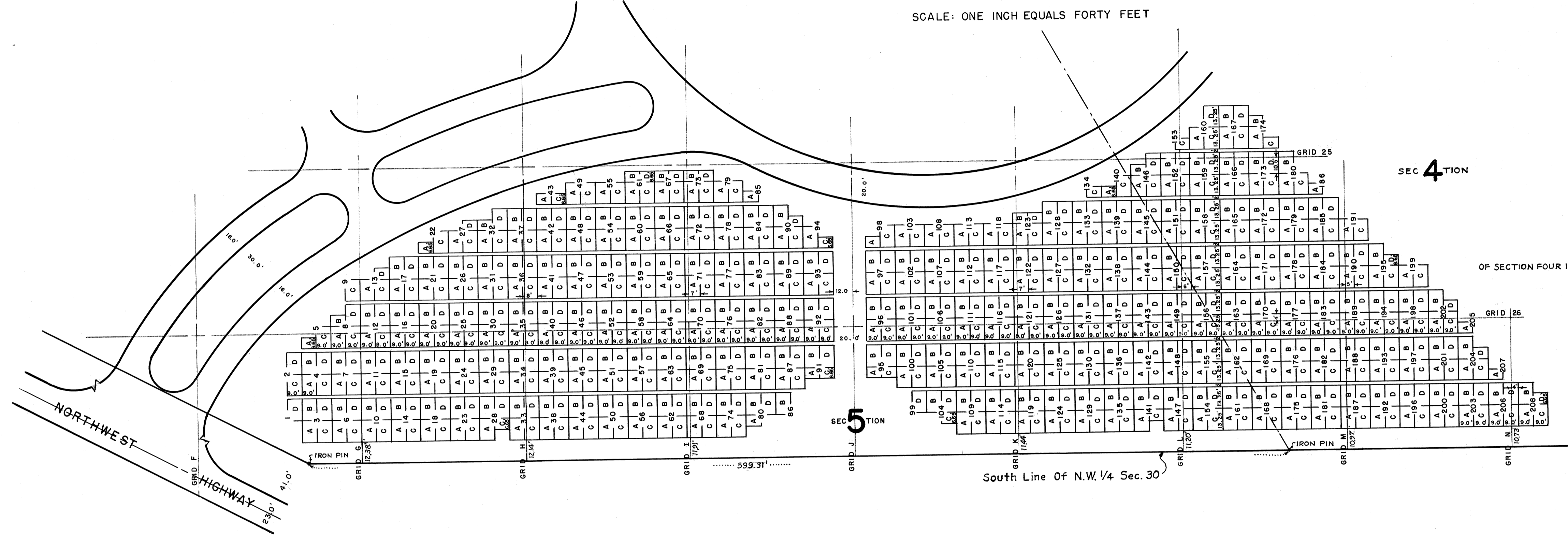

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT THE UNDERSIGNED, MEMORIAL GARDENS ASSOCIATION, AN EXPRESS TRUST, WITH PRINCIPAL OFFICES AT OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA, HAS CAUSED TO BE SURVEYED, STAKED AND PLATTED INTO LOTS, DRIVEWAYS, WALKS AND PARKS, THAT PORTION OF LOTS ONE AND TWO AND THE EAST HALF (E 1/2) OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW 1/4) OF SECTION THIRTY (30), TOWNSHIP THIRTEEN NORTH (T. 13 N.) RANGE FOUR WEST (R. 4 W.), OKLAHOMA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

THE "GARDEN OF DEVOTION" A SUBDIVISION OF SECTION FIVE AND A PART OR PORTION OF SECTION FOUR IN "CHAPEL HILL MEMORIAL GARDENS" AS RECORDED IN BOOK 27, PAGE 93, REGISTRAR OF DEEDS, OKLAHOMA COUNTY, OKLAHOMA.

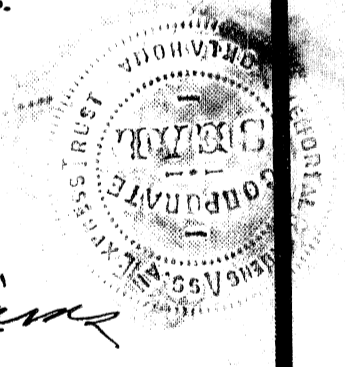

THE MEMORIAL GARDENS ASSOCIATION, AN EXPRESS TRUST, HEREBY WARRANTS THE TITLE OF SAID LANDS TO BE FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL ENCUMBRANCES, EXCEPT OIL AND GAS LEASE OF SINCLAIR PRAIRIE OIL COMPANY, SAID COMPANY HAVING AGREED NOT TO DRILL OR CONDUCT OPERATIONS ON SAID LANDS, HOWEVER.

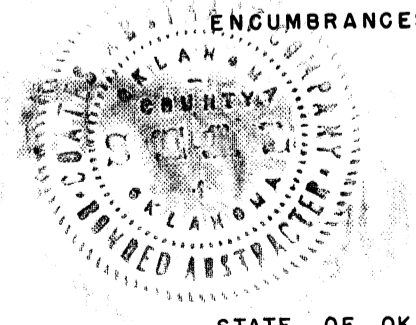

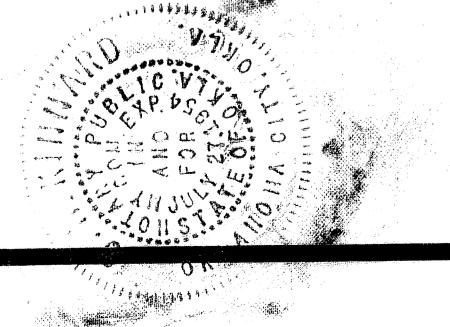
