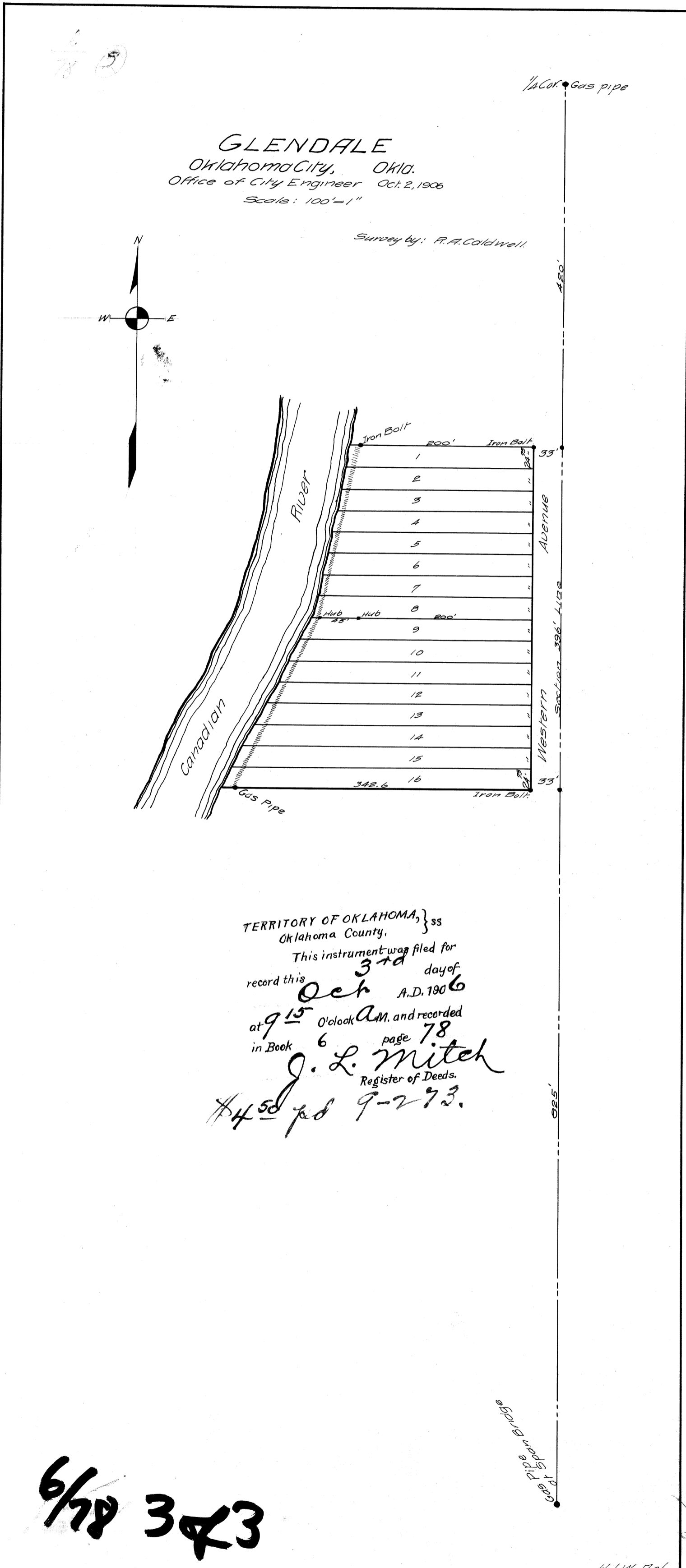


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C E R T I F I C A T E .

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, W.H. Brown and Ellen Brown, husband and wife, being the owners in fee-simple of a tract of land situated in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory and described as follows:- Two (2) acres, more or less, in Lot One (1), Section Five (5), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Three (3) West, I.M., more particularly described as follows:- Beginning at a point Four Hundred Twenty (420) feet South of the North East Corner of the South East Quarter of Section Five (5), Township Eleven (11) North, Rang Three (3) West, I.M., and running South Three Hundred Ninety-six (396) feet along the Section Line, thence, West to the East bank of the North Canadian River, thence, in a Northeasterly direction along the said East bank of the North Canadian River to a point that is Three Hundred Ninety-six feet North of the South line, thence, East and parallel with the South line to the point or place of beginning.

That we have caused said tract to be surveyed and platted into Blocks, Lots, Streets and Alleys, and named the said plat "Glendale Addition to Oklahoma City", and we, the said W.H. Brown and Ellen Brown do hereby dedicate the streets and alleys to the public use forever.
