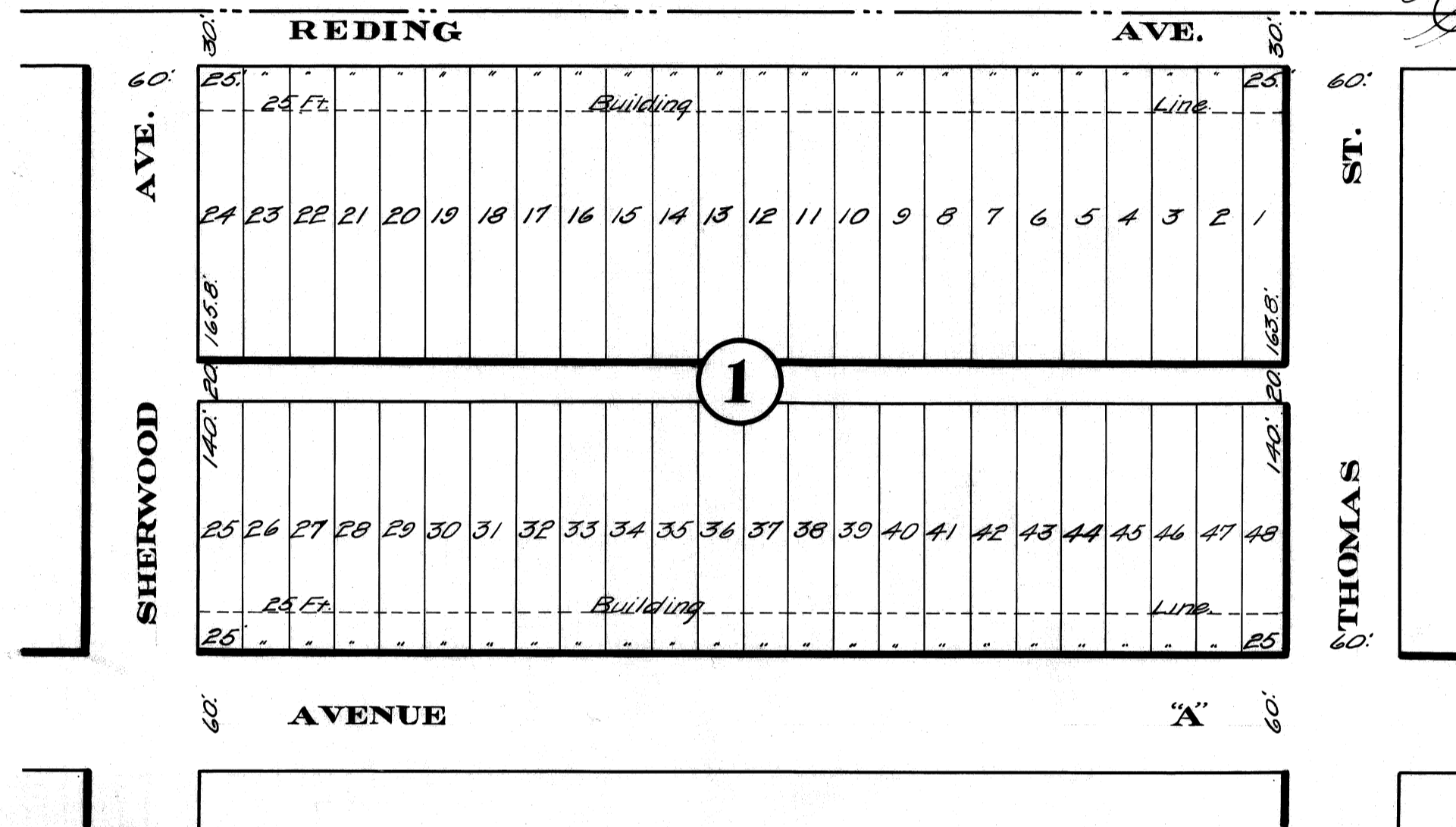

his wife, being the owners of Block One (1) Petrasek Addition to Oklahoma
City, Oklahoma, have caused the same to be sub-divided into lots, street
and an alley, and that the annexed map or plat is a correct representation
of said Block as sub-divided, which we hereby designate and name 'Gorden-
dale Addition' to the City of Oklahoma City, and dedicate the street and
alley as shown on said map or plat to the public.

RESTRICTIONS:

No. 1 - A building line is hereby established obligatory on all
purchasers of lots in this addition a distance of Twenty-Five (25') Feet
from all front streets.

No. 2 - No lots or lot or any portion of either shall ever be sold
to any person or persons of African descent, known as Negroes.
