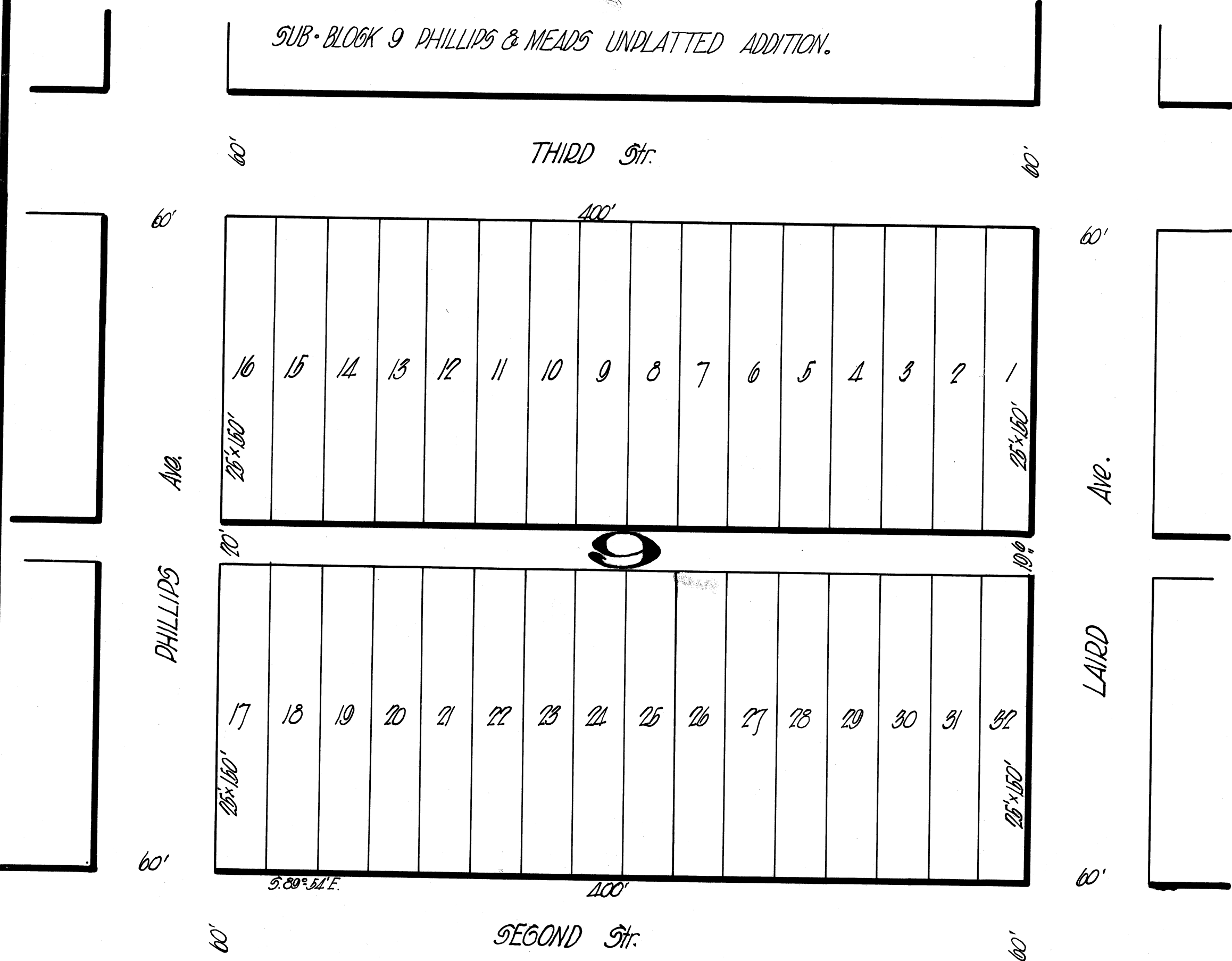

of the Sub-divisional Plat of Block Nine (9) of Phillips and Mead's Addition to Oklahoma City, O. T.

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THIS INSTRUMENT Witnesseth: That we, Julia E. Gray of Rosque -----County, State of Texas -----, (a single woman) Lizzie A. Rockwood of Oklahoma County, Territory of Oklahoma, (a single woman), and Lucy G. Peterson and G. Peterson, her husband, of Bexar County, State of Texas, the owners of the land hereinafter described, have caused to be platted and surveyed into lots, Block Nine (9) of Phillips and Mead's Unplatted Addition to Oklahoma City, O. T. That we have caused to be made a correct plat of said tract of land as surveyed; the land surveyed and platted aforesaid being a part of the north-east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south-east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty-four (34) in township twelve (12) north, range three (3) west of the Indian Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at a point three hundred and twenty-five (325) feet south and sixty (60) feet east of north-west corner of the north-east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south-east quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty-four (34) in township twelve (12) north, range three (3) west of the Indian Meridian; thence east four hundred and thirty (430) feet; thence south three hundred and eighty (380) feet; thence west four hundred and thirty (430) feet; thence north three hundred and eighty (380) feet, to the place of beginning. And we do hereby designate the same as Gray's ~~Sub-division~~ "Sub-division" of Block Nine (9) of Phillips and Mead's Unplatted Addition to Oklahoma, O. T., and we do hereby dedicate all the streets, avenues, and the alley, as shown by said plat, to public use.

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SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, J. P. Barnard, of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory, do hereby certify that I am a Surveyor by occupation. That at the instance of Julia E. Gray of Bosque County, State of Texas, ~~Phillips~~, Lizzie A. Rockwood of Oklahoma County, Oklahoma Territory, Lucy G. Peterson and G. Peterson of Bexar County, State of Texas, I surveyed into lots and alleys Block nine (9) in Phillips & Mead's ^{unplatted} Addition to Oklahoma City, O. T., embracing a part of the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section thirty-four (34) in township twelve (12) north of range three (3) west, of the Indian Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at a point three hundred and twenty-five (325) feet south, and sixty (60) feet east of the north-west corner of the north-east quarter (1/4) of the south-east quarter (1/4) of section thirty-four (34) in township twelve (12) north, of range three (3) west aforesaid; thence east four hundred and thirty (430) feet; thence south ~~three hundred and eighty (380)~~ feet; thence west four hundred and thirty (430) feet; thence north three hundred and eighty (380) feet to the place of beginning.
